- **Bookbags** – Please can all children bring their Book Bag (if this is lost please contact our uniform supplier to order a replacement) and Reading Record to school every day so that we can share information about your child's progress in reading.
- **Reading**
 - **Guided Reading** – children are now reading Bug Club Guided Reading books online each week. After reading them at school, they will be allocated to your child to read at home during the week. Your child should read these books to you, completing each of the Bug Questions. Please record how they are getting on in your child's reading record. I appreciate you are now doing Doodle at home, but we really need to keep up the reading too!
 - **Changing Paper Books** – children have the opportunity to change these every morning, please make sure they are aware if you would like them to change this book, whilst I ask the children if they need to change their book, I am not doing this with them.
- **Doodle** – Please see the email sent to all Year 1 parents on 5th May 2021. Following the email, please remember next week we will be focusing on Doodle Spell at School. Please support your children with Doodle Maths at home. Can we help all of the children stay in their 'Green Zones?'
- **Spare Uniform** - We have lots of spare school uniform which has been donated to the school. If your child needs an additional jumper, P.E. t-shirt please let us know and we will send one home with them.
- **P.E. Kit** – Please can you ensure that your child is wearing appropriate school P.E. kit. This is: School P.E. T Shirt, Black shorts or black jogging bottoms, Trainers (these should be trainers appropriate for running in and not their school shoes). On cooler days a black hoody or sweatshirt can be worn.

Year 2

- **Bookbags** - From 10th May 2021, please send your child's bookbag, book and reading record to school every day. If you need to purchase a new bookbag please contact our uniform supplier. Please do not send your child in with a rucksack (unless they travel on the school bus and this helps with keeping their things together) as we do not have space to store these in the cloakroom.

- PE Days – Our PE days are Tuesday and Thursday. Please can the children come to school in their PE kits. Black shorts or tracksuit and red Roundwood T-shirts.
- Wellies - Please can all children have a pair of wellies in school as we are using the field every day for breaks and lunch times and if it has rained then it is a bit muddy for just shoes. These are also needed for our outdoor learning sessions. Please could they come into school in a sturdy carrier bag so that they can be hung on pegs in the cloakroom. If they are already in school, then a bag would be appreciated to store them in so that we are not tripping over them in the cloakroom.
- Doodle – We have worked really hard this week to ensure that 100% of the class are in the green target zone in both their English and Maths Doodle. We would appreciate your support at home, particularly over the weekends, to keep them there. If there are issues accessing either of the Apps at home, then please let me know and we will arrange a time for them to complete their Doodle in school.
